FR MARTIN WRITES: As I prepare to leave Chelmsford after more than three years among you, I find myself reflecting on what it means to be entrusted with a parish, not as a possession, but as a responsibility held for a season.

In my years of ordained ministry, I have come to see that the Gospel is most fully revealed not in grand words, but in quiet, faithful living. In your kindness during bereavements, your gentleness when I faltered, your patience with one another in times of struggle and care, and your faithful presence week after week, I have witnessed faith made tangible. You have shown me what it means to be Church, not perfect, but present; not without struggle, but never giving up on one another.

I leave you in the care of Fr Barto, confident that you will welcome him with the same warmth and generosity you have shown me. In him, you will find a shepherd attentive to your needs and a companion in faith.

It has been a privilege and a joy to serve among you. You have left a lasting mark upon me, and I will carry you in my prayers always. May you continue to dwell in God's mercy and hope, living the promise of the psalmist's words: "The Lord is good to all; his mercy is over all that he has made" (Psalm 145:9), allowing that mercy to shape your lives and sustain one another.
